## **ROSMOULD-2009**

### **PRESS-RELEASE MOULDS. DIE MOULDS. STAMPS.**

ROSMOULD - the Russian specialized mould-making technologies exhibition will take place from June 3 to 5, 2009 in Crocus-Expo exhibition centre.

ROSMOULD covers all the spheres of the industry uniting specialists in design, production, prototyping, engineering, programming and tooling from all over the world. That's why it can truly be called the "gate to the Russian and CIS mould market".

ROSMOULD is a one of a kind event on the whole post-soviet territory that allows manufacturers to expand their business towards a new market, establish new relations and share experience. In 2009, the exhibition has attracted more than 189 companies from 15 countries on the area of 6000 sq. m., with collective stands from Germany, Italy, China, Portugal, Taiwan, Finland, and France. For ROSMOULD 2010 the exhibition site has been extended to 10 000 sq.m. It is estimated that the show will account for 300 companies from 20 countries.

Traditionally the International Instrumental Summit will pass during the show, allowing guests and participants to get a deeper scoop in modern mould production, acquire new knowledge in innovative tooling and share their ideas on the development of modern tools and on the optimization of the whole production process.

The event is organized by the international exhibition company Expo-Mold, with participation and support of the Moscow Confederation of Manufacturers and Businessmen, the Moscow Chamber of Industry and Commerce and such media as World of Plastics, Plastics, Polymer materials, Composite world, International News of the World of Plastics magazines. It's hard to underestimate the meaning of such an event for the Russian market as it's the only exhibition in the country dedicated to such a narrowly specialized sector as mould-making. ROSMOULD is a common ground which unites specialist from different spheres and industries that allows them to find new solutions for the production process and develop their business, expanding the market they act in and employing new technologies. M.V. Blohin – the chief executive of the National Automobile Components Producer Association said: "the conduction of such an event as ROSMOULD is an important step in the establishment of a technological basis of an effective infrastructure in the Russian automotive industry."
